

NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE KITTEN OWNERS

- **Amoramist** Kittens are only considered "reserved" upon receipt of a non-refundable 25% Deposit. All the kittens pet, show or breed are sold under contract of care, only if I the breeder am unable to supply the kitten would your deposit be refunded.
- I reserve the right of refusal for the sale of any kitten/cat pictured on this web-site at anytime, for any reason.
- All the kittens be it pet or breed are placed on the GCCF register, Pets on the non active register must be neutered at the age of six months of age.
- **Amoramist** Kittens all go to their new homes with an accurate pedigree; Food samples and toy. They are wormed and front lined against fleas (you should never buy a kitten that has fleas they could have tape worm). All of my Kittens are also fully vaccinated twice against FLU and ENTIRITIS. They also come with a free insurance policy that covers them for six weeks. They are at their most vulnerable at the time that they leave the breeder so at **Amoramist** we ensure that you are insured for that time, I strongly recommend you continue with the kitten insurance once the free period expires.
- Contracts are for the kitten's protection and none will be sold without a contract.
- New kitten owners will be asked to sign a contract .This states 'should the kitten be unable to stay in his or her new home, he or she will be returned to me the breeder'.
- I always invite the prospective new parents of my babies to my home to ensure that the right kitten is placed with the right family. My babies are very precious to me and I always like to ensure that they are going to have the best life possible with their new family. I also ensure that all of the kittens are fully inoculated, wormed, litter trained and are at least 13 weeks old before they go to their new home.
- I do not like my kittens visited before they have had their first vaccination at nine weeks old, this means they have at least some protection against the outside world and all it has to throw at it. I love my babies and I want them to be happy so I do try to make sure they have the best chance they can have, they mean so much to me. My Vet will give the little kittens a medical at nine weeks old and again at the age of twelve weeks, my Vet will not give the last vaccination if they are not A1; also I would not let them go to their new owners if I know that they are not well.
- I am always only a phone call or email away for help and advise if needed, or to hear news of the babies throughout their lives .I love to receive photographs and remember if they are good ones they will, with your permission, go into the past kitten page of my web-site. Keeping in touch also helps me with future breeding programmes as this gives me a good idea of my kittens as they grow up.
- I do not let my kittens out and unless you have a safe garden or a house and run, I would not want you to home one of my kittens, the World outside is not a caring one, we have cars, we have cycles and they are all a danger to the kitten. There is also illness that other cats carry, and can so easy give to your pedigree kitten or cat, such as AIDs and many others. Unfortunately we also have people that would think nothing of just picking your kitten up and taking it home. Kittens are happy to live indoors and when they become cats they love nothing better than to stay indoors in the warmth and snuggle up with you!!
